FEES

Why Fees?

Fees are one piece of the pie that fund theatre for LuHi

- Fees make up about 25% of cost of the musical
- Ticket sales make up about 50% of the cost of the musical
- 25% covered by other sources (ad sales, donations, funding from school, etc.)

Fees cover additional costs that do not need to be paid later

- Meals during tech week
- Shirts
- Snacks backstage, video for cast members, etc.

CASTING

The Casting Process

Not everyone will get a part - with the interest level, there will be cuts for actors and techies

Trust the directors - we view the whole picture, there are dozens of deciding factors

If you are unhappy with casting, the STUDENT should talk with the director, not the parent

The best thing you can do is prepare really well - there are tips on how to do this in Canvas. Also connect with a theatre veteran. We have a brand new leadership team that can help you prepare.

Common Misconceptions of Casting

- Underclassmen / transfer students can't get leads
- Assuming I'll get the same level of role I did last year
- I will only be considered for the role I am auditioning for
- I have to be a good actor, singer and dancer to get cast
- I didn't get a good part because the directors don't like me

COMMUNICATION

Communication for students and parents

Rehearsal Calendar

Check Canvas frequently

Conflicts

- Avoid if at all possible it is a big deal if you miss even one rehearsal
- No more than 3 missed rehearsals

Communication with directors

- Email the directors
- Do it ASAP not day of, no surprise appointments please
